Aft Deck

Upon boarding this Grand Banks 52 Europa, you are greeted by her large covered teak side decks allowing you to move freely from bow to stern. The spacious aft cockpit provides ample room to add your favorite table and chairs for relaxing and enjoying a magnificent sunset. Descending through the large flush teak hatch in the cockpit sole, one gains access to the enormous lazarette storage area with built in storage racks and entrance to the well laid out stand-up engine room.

Flybridge

A built-in staircase from the aft deck provides security and safe passage to the spacious flying bridge with adequate space for a large dinghy and socializing. Both the bridge area with helm and full electronics and the mid seating area with fridge, freezer, icemaker, and BBQ grill set an impressive stage for entertaining with abundant seating and a large hand-made teak table perfectly suited for sunset dinners. The well planned bridge area and helm provide the captain with room for all the tools and toys that make cruising a pleasure.

Salon

From the aft deck, one gains entry to the spacious salon through a beautiful teak double sliding door that opens for a grand view aft. The salon is an open plan affording wonderful views from the spacious salon and pilothouse windows for an unobstructed view of passing scenery. The beauty continues with teak parquet sole beneath cut-to-fit rugs, built-in large custom crafted L-shaped sofas, a retractable flat screen TV, and a Bose sound system that provides a grand location for relaxing in comfort and style.

Dinette and Galley

Forward from the salon is a dinette on the port side opposite the large open-plan galley to starboard. The spacious dinette features teak table and bench seats with camel colored ultra leather fitted cushions and large pull-out storage drawers under each bench seat. The U-shaped galley with its large granite counter-tops, separate Sub-Zero fridge and freezer, dishwasher, convection microwave, and ceramic cook top are a gourmets dream.

Pilothouse and Lower Helm

Just forward of the galley is the magnificently laid out pilothouse with its center line Stidd helm chair and extensive electronics package. The 360 degree visibility from the helm is a mariners dream and the pass-thru in the galley and salon provide an expansive view aft for easy docking and cruising comfort. Adorning the helm area, a bar with an icemaker to starboard and a forward facing settee with a teak folding table to port make catering to guests a breeze. The two pilothouse doors can be opened for great ventilation as well as providing easy access forward and aft from the pilothouse.

Guest Staterooms and Head

Moving forward from the pilothouse on the port side is a large staircase with landing leading to the sleeping accommodations below deck. Throughout the staterooms, the teak wood theme continues from sole to ceiling. On the starboard side of the lower companionway is the guest stateroom with double bed and underberth storage drawers, hanging locker, and a flat screen TV. Just forward and on the port side of the companionway, one will find the guest head with separate walk-in shower. Moving forward is the voluminous VIP stateroom that rivals the master stateroom on other yachts of this type and size. The tall ceiling and extra large opening port holes provide light and an enjoyable sense of space. Family members and/or guests will feel at home in either of these accommodations.

Master Stateroom

Moving aft through the companionway and down two small steps is the entrance to the full beam master stateroom with ensuite split head facilities. As with all three staterooms on this yacht, large opening port holes provide a wonderful source of light and ventilation. Aft is the centerline queen bed with built-in nightstands on either side. To port is a large hanging locker and chest of drawers with built-in dressing vanity and parsons stool. To starboard there is yet another large hanging locker and chest of six drawers. The generous storage in the master suite continues as one enters the head to starboard with its sandstone HPL countertops and additional storage cabinetry. To port one will find the large separate shower facility.
