You will not find better attention to detail and joinery work anywhere, at any price. The open feel and amount of light in the cabin is unlike any vessel of this size that you may have been aboard.

Whether harbor hopping in New England, sunset cruising along the gulf shore or lunching on Bimini, the Marlow Prowler will show you off at your best.

## Galley

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The gentleman for whom this yacht was built asked for a few things to satisfy his particular needs - a wine cooler below, a grill up top for grilling without filling the boat with smoke, a microwave for cooking side dishes, plenty of refrigeration, and an ice chest to quickly cool warm drinks with a bag of ice. We accomplished all this for him without altering the open feel of the cockpit and salon.

## Construction

Norsemen Shipyard is an environmentally conscious facility featuring the very best in computer systems, advanced tools and machinery; and boasts a talented workforce in every department, trained by some of the top master yacht builders in the world. Due to the advanced construction techniques pioneered and proven by the Marlow Explorer Series, we are able to offer the interior and cockpit volume of a much larger yacht. This complex tooling and production method rids the yacht of space-robbing heavy wooden framing commonly seen. Replaced by composite sandwiches similar to high performance aircraft, racing yachts and race cars, the technique allows far greater interior volume while producing a much stronger and lower maintenance yacht.

Cat-like performance, highly advanced technology and the finest attention to detail have created another benchmark for excellence from Marlow Yachts that others can only attempt to emulate.

## Electrical

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Even though she is gas powered with triple 250 Yamaha outboards she has a 5KW Onan diesel generator with its own 30 gallon diesel tank. The diesel generator produces a fraction of the dangerous carbon monoxide fumes and runs at a lower RPM offering quiet operation.

## Deck, Helm and Cabin Area

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Even the steering wheel is an example of superior craftsmanship. The wheel is beautifully hand crafted out of teak and ebony. The Stidd chair and footrest elevate you to a good vantage point to run the boat. The console is clean and simple with easy access to everything.

Another nice surprise, a separate air-conditioning unit that will heat or cool the helm area. On a hot day in the slow speed zone this is a welcome addition. The side windows and overhead hatches open for natural ventilation when it is nice outside.

## Comfort & Convenience

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One of the biggest surprises when you go below is how nice the head is. Granite counters, Grohe faucets and shower, full size Vacuflush head, and lots of natural light will make you feel like you are on a much larger yacht. Instead of trying to pack bunks into a 37' boat, the Prowler was designed to allow a cruising couple to sleep comfortably while still providing seating for eight for day cruising. The settee below is very comfortable when you want to get out of the weather and you will not get that claustrophobic feeling because you can see out in all directions.

- Flagstaffs, teak, bow and stern
- Fresh water faucet, inside forward deck locker
- Grab rails, stainless steel
- Rub rail, heavy-duty 316L stainless steel
- Safety rails, stainless steel
- Skylight hatches with blinds in cabins (two on bridgedeck, one in cabin with screen)

## Mechanical

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The three 250 HP outboards are easy to turn with the wheel thanks to the power steering system. The trim tabs will take out any list when you have a strong crosswind. All the system components and molded fiberglass components are the best we can buy or build. From the stainless steel anchor to the finishing of the bilges, you will not find a better built or finished boat.
