Main Salon, Amidship

The salon is "just right". The wetbar is to starboard just aft of the lower helm. The sink and counter area are hidden behind a beautiful teak tambor door and drop down front panel. The icemaker is installed below to the right side with drawers down the left side.

Immediately aft of the bar is an L-settee with the signature Grand Banks teak drop leaf table. Opposite this settee is an entertainment center with TV/VCR storage and hook-ups behind teak tambor doors. It is flanked by two very comfortable barrel chairs that swivel. In addition to the barrel chairs, there is also 2 dining chairs and a breakfast bar with 2 swivel chairs. The salon features custom drapes, Levelor blinds and Ultrasuede upholstery. The decor is a complement of neutrals and burgundys giving her a very rich look and warm ambiance. She is ready to make that cruise you have always wanted to take.

Galley

The galley is just aft of the forward cabin and features plenty of storage with a pantry, china, utensil, cookware and dinnerware storage. The galley also carries 9 storage drawers and the countertops are formica.

Master Stateroom, Below Deck Aft

The master stateroom is aft, down three steps and features a double and a twin berth with custom mattress covers, pillows, shams and curtains. There is a six drawer dresser and a double hanging locker in addition to the four under berth drawers plus chart storage. The ensuite head includes Vacu-flush toilet, a cultured marble basin and a separate shower stall with automatic sump pump, 2 medicine cabinets and two drawers along with under sink storage. There are six opening side windows, a hatch and aft cabin door. The master stateroom also carries a Zenith 9" TV/VCR.

Guest Stateroom, Below Deck Forward

The guest stateroom is a forward V-berth. There is a hanging locker, 6 drawers and an under berth cabinet. There is a large hatch and two opening side windows. The guest head has it's own stall shower.

Next to the forward stateroom is the guest head and laundry with over/under washer/dryer. The guest head has Vacu-flush toilet, faux marble basin and separate shower stall with seat and automatic sump pump.

Flybridge

The Flybridge helm also carries a Datamarine sounder and an intercom.

Just aft of the upper helm with it's back to back seating and teak rim wheel under a bimini with full enclosure is an L-settee with teak cocktail table. She carries custom navy sunbrella cushions and stereo speakers for entertainment. On the bridge is also a large console locker for storage.
